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I am writing in support of Jack Frazier's petition to stabilize the name of the Aldabra tortoise by retaining the names *Aldabrachelys* and *Testudo gigantea*, and rendering *Testudo dussumieri* invalid. Frazier clearly and convincingly argues his case in the petition. In this case, *Aldabrachelys* and *Testudo gigantea* have been the norm in the scientific community when referring to the Aldabra tortoise. Changing the name based on a dubious holotype would cause terrible confusion, unnecessarily complicating future conservation and research.
